



Our privacy policy and GDPR compliance

Personal Information Controller

Under the YULIKO WEDDING trademark, entrepreneur Yulia Blumenberg (tax number 105 335 637 of the register of Georgia ID110072) and entrepreneur Pavel Blyumenberg (tax number 105 332 998 of the register of Georgia ID4491636) operate. According to the GDPR regulation, the above individuals are the Controller of Clients' Personal Information when working under the trademark YULIKO WEDDING agency (YULIKO WEDDING) and are implied in the text of the Privacy Policy ("YULIKO WEDDING agency" "YULIKO WEDDING", "we", "our") below.

About Privacy Policy

YULIKO WEDDING agency respects the privacy of its clients and protects their personal information in all available ways. Below you can find out how we may collect and use personal information, as well as clarify the related rights and capabilities of our Visitors and Clients.

We ask that you carefully read this document and make sure that you fully understand and agree with it before accessing our site.

If you have not read it in full, did not understand something or do not accept the terms of this Privacy Policy, then you must immediately leave this site!

Your consent to the use of Personal Data

This YULIKO WEDDING Privacy Policy describes how we may collect and use Personal Information relating to each of our unregistered visitors ("Visitor") and registered wedding customers ("Customer") in connection with their use of our website www.yuliko-wedding.com

You can use our website only if you fully agree with this Privacy Policy, you express and confirm your knowledge and full agreement with this Privacy Policy, including with regard to the collection and processing of your Personal Information, as defined and described below.

Please note: in accordance with applicable law, you are not required to provide us with any information. However, in this case, we will not be able to provide you with the necessary services for organizing your wedding in Georgia. You hereby confirm, warrant and agree that any information that you provide to us is provided at your own will and consent for use for the purposes described in this document.

Anonymized information

We collect non-identifiable and non-identifying information relating to Visitors or unidentified Customers that may be accessed by us or collected automatically when using our site ("Anonymized Information"). Such anonymized information does not allow us to identify the Visitor or Customer from whose device it was collected. Anonymized information collected by us mainly consists of technical or summary information about the use, such as views of Visitors and Customers, the sequence of clicks when using the pages of the site, the click map of the session of using the site and page scrolling, unidentified information regarding the devices of the Visitor or Customer, the operating system, internet browser, screen resolution, language and keyboard settings, internet service provider, links to login and logout pages, session date and time, etc.

What Personal Information We Collect

We collect personally identifiable information from our Customers, namely that information that identifies an individual or may be of a private nature ("Personal Information"). The personal information we collect mainly consists of contact information (i.e. email address and phone number), billing information (name, physical billing address, payment method and order details), details of your session on our site (IP addresses, geolocation and / or individual device ID), details of connected user accounts of third-party resources (for example, email or username for connected PayPal, Google or Facebook accounts), scanned ID and family documents provided to us position (such as an identity card, driver's license, passport or divorce certificate), correspondence (including that made through or uploaded to our postal services), photographs of Customers and any other Personal information provided to us by Customers voluntarily and / or User trees when they access our site. To avoid misinterpretation, any Non-Personal Information that relates to or is associated with Personal Information (for example, to improve the quality of the services we offer) is considered and treated by us as Personal Information for as long as this possibility exists. The personal information we collect is used to organize the work of our services for working with Customers and providing services to Customers.

Purpose of collecting information

1. The provision of personal data is necessary for the fulfillment of the contract, without their provision the controller will not be able to fulfill its contractual obligations;
2. To provide services to our Customers;
3. In order to develop, customize and improve our services based on general or individual preferences, experience of use or difficulties encountered by Visitors and Customers;
4. In order to be able to contact our Visitors and Customers for general or individual notifications related to the provision of services and advertising messages;
5. Sending commercial offers and other marketing activities;
6. To create aggregate statistical information that we can use to provide and improve the quality of our services;
7. To improve our ability to protect data and prevent fraud;
8. In order to comply with applicable laws and regulations.

Data storage

Our company website is hosted on the Wix.com platform. Wix.com provides us with an online platform that allows us to sell our products and services to you. Your data may be stored in the Wix.com Data Warehouse, Wix.com Databases and Shared Apps. Wix.com stores your data on secure servers behind a firewall (firewall). Personal and Non-personal information of our Visitors and Clients is stored on the secure servers of the company and the servers of Wix.com and Gmail services; anonymized information of our Visitors and Clients is stored on the servers of analytical services Google Analytics, Yandex Metrica and others.

Localization of Personal Information

We do not have the technical ability to localize Personal Information on the territory of individual countries. If you are a resident of a country that requires the Personal Information of its residents to be contained within the territorial boundaries of that jurisdiction, you acknowledge and agree that we may continue to collect, store and use your Personal Information in other countries.

Transfer of personal information

We undertake not to transfer Personal Information of Customers, except for the following cases:

1. Transfer of Personal Information of Customers to state bodies of Georgia (Ministry of Justice, marriage registration authorities) for filing an application for marriage registration and for marriage registration; state bodies of Georgia (Ministry of Justice) for translation and apostille of marriage certificate, as well as Consular bodies of the respective countries, if it is necessary for consular legalization.
2. Transfer of Personal Information of Customers to partner organizations that provide us with services for the preparation of Customer documents for filing an application for marriage in Georgia (translation and notary bureaus).
3. Transfer of Personal Information of Customers to partner organizations that provide us with additional services in order to best meet the needs of Customers (for example, accommodation

booking services) - in the minimum amount necessary for the provision of high-quality services and only for use for this purpose.

4. Transfer of Personal Information to law enforcement agencies in whose jurisdiction we operate - by a court decision or a request from the investigating authorities.

Use of tracking technologies

The owners of the platform of our website Wix.com and third-party software developers use tracking technologies - cookies, web beacons, Flash and HTML5, and others to optimize the operation of services, identify technical problems and identify user preferences.

In accordance with the GDPR, we are not required to obtain the consent of our site visitors when using cookies on the site.

It is important to note that third party services may have their own policies regarding how they collect and store information. As these are external services, their policies do not apply to YULIKO WEDDING's Privacy Policy.

Communication with customers

We can contact you to notify you of the status of your application, help eliminate technical problems with your access to the site, resolve a disputable situation, resolve issues of payment for the package of wedding services purchased from us, get your opinion through polls, send information about our offers, to notify of site updates and new services or, if necessary, to contact you to ensure compliance with our contractual obligations, applicable local laws and any agreement we may have with you. For these purposes, we can contact you by e-mail, phone, through messages in messengers, by post.

Refusal to process Personal data

Please note that in this case we will not be able to provide you with the services you need.

Changes to the Privacy Policy

We reserve the right to change the details of this Privacy Policy at any time, so please review it regularly. Changes and clarifications will take effect immediately after they are posted on our website. If we make material changes to this policy, we will notify you that it has been updated so that you are aware of what information we collect, how we use it, and under what circumstances, if any, we use and / or disclose it.

General GDPR Compliance

YULIKO WEDDING supports the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), which entered into force on May 25, 2018.

In accordance with the requirements of the GDPR, we are working to protect the personal data of our Customers.

Also, in accordance with this regulation, we are ready to provide our Customers with access to their personal information stored with us and to exercise the "right to be forgotten" - the complete removal of personal information from our databases at the personal request of the Customer.

Storage periods for Personal Information

Personal information of Customers is stored for 3 (three) years from the date of termination of the contractual relationship. Upon the expiration of this period, Personal Information is destroyed in a way that excludes its recovery.

At the request of the Customer, Personal information can be completely removed from our databases at the personal request of the Customer - "the right to be forgotten."
